Restrictions:

- Infrastructure placed in areas other than the aisle may not protrude into the aisle
- Infrastructure that temporarily enters the aisle during the task execution is permitted
- Anything installed on the aisle must not block people from passing through
- *When wiring the container, use a removable type, that can be released during transportation for example by truck (e.g. magnetic connection)
- Provide a tripod or similar when installing a camera as a sensor
- It is not permitted to install any infrastructure outside the convenience store
- There are no written restrictions on specific devices because participants are expected to come up
 with a variety of innovative ways to use different devices but serious consideration must be paid to
 human safety. Judges would reserve the right to prohibit a device. If in doubt it's better to ask the
 committee before hand.
